Dear New and Returning Lifeguards,

Our lifeguards contribute a valuable service to our Long Beach Island communities and in order to provide the best service possible our lifeguards need various certifications and specialized training. In order to plan your summer accordingly, this mailing includes information about all the required paperwork, training, and certifications.

All lifeguards must have current American Red Cross Emergency Response and Professional Rescuer CPR/AED/PDT (*and Oxygen Administration Certification if you are at least 18 years old*) certifications or take and pass the above courses through LBTBP at a cost of \$10.00 for each American Red Cross course. New guards who have not completed at least two sessions of the Lifeguard In Training (LIT) Program with level 2 or higher certification must pass the LBTBP Ocean Lifeguard Training Course (OLTC) before beginning work on the beach. You will be paid for your attendance at these courses upon being hired as a lifeguard by LBTBP.

All lifeguards must: Submit an application— you must list any previous lifeguard experience on the application. Pass a swim test— the mandatory swim test *must* be passed by **May 29th** (**there are no scheduled swim tests after May 29th**). Attend the orientation meeting. Either receive Hepatitis B vaccinations or fill out the declination form. During the summer, lifeguards must also complete competition requirements to demonstrate on-going, in ocean, rescue competency. The 1000-meter ocean swim is required of all lifeguards.

LBTBP lifeguard applicants who are 18 years of age or older are required to obtain a physical annually (form attached) and submit a background check annually (this form will be mailed to you once your application is received, you pass the swim test, and are offered a position). Working papers are required for all employees under the age of 18. All paperwork (I-9, W-4, "Working Papers", etc.) must be completed *before* taking the swim test. All paperwork may be completed at the St. Francis Aquatic Center conference room during designated swim test times and/or at LBTBP headquarters Monday through Friday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

All officers (Chiefs, Captains, Lieutenants, LIT Instructors and IRB Directors) must be currently certified American Red Cross Emergency Response Instructors and also must be Emergency Response certified (or higher). These requirements apply to returning officers as well as to individuals seeking officer positions for the first time.

If you are a returning officer or you would like to apply for an officer position— you must inform the beach patrol office in writing to state which position you wish to keep or obtain. Your application, officer request letter, and a written summary of all relevant qualifications must be received by 4:00 p.m. on **Monday, May 17th**. **Please mark lower left hand corner of envelope "Lifeguard Application"**. **The last swim test is May 29th (there are no scheduled swim tests after May 29th).**

If you are applying for an officer position, or spring or fall crew, you must have a current drivers license. If you have a driver's license from a state other than New Jersey, you must submit a letter from your states Department of Motor Vehicles stating that you have a valid drivers license that it is in good standing. This is mandatory for all new and veteran officers! This is easily done online through the DMV and *must* be done every year.

Applications are due *as soon as possible* for new lifeguards and by **Saturday, May 22nd**, for **veteran lifeguards**. **Veteran lifeguards** will not be guaranteed a lifeguard position if applications are received after **May 22nd**, and if the swim test is taken after **May 22nd**.

Hiring documentation and application will not be sent by mail. Please download the lifeguard application at <http://www.lbtbp.com/employment/> and send all documentation to LBTBP *as soon as possible*.

Competition for ocean lifeguard positions at LBTBP will be strong this year. Swim test times, background checks, interviews as needed, etc. will be used to determine whom is offered a position as a LBTBP ocean lifeguard. **Do not wait until the last minute to complete your application requirements and to take your swim test.**

The rest of this packet provides details about these requirements. Please read all of the enclosed material carefully.

Don't forget: you must sign up for all courses in advance by mailing the enclosed registration form to Long Beach Township Beach Patrol, 6805 Long Beach Boulevard, Brant Beach, NJ 08008 or by calling Beach Patrol Headquarters at (609) 361-1200.

Application Deadlines

All required documentation, including application, from Long Beach Township Beach Patrol veterans must be received before you take your swim test and absolutely no later than the **Saturday, May 22nd** swim test. All applications from new lifeguard applicants must be received as soon as possible. All additional documentation, including application must be received on or before **May 29th**. All applications for **officer/supervisor** positions must be received by **Monday, May 17th**.

Swim Test Calendar

Both veteran and new lifeguards must swim 600 feet (200 yards; which is 8 lengths of the new St. Francis Community Center pool) in 2:50 minutes or less. If you are a veteran guard who has worked for LBTBP for ten (10) years or more and are: 1) between 30 to 39 years of age, your swim test time must be 2:55 minutes or less; 2) between 40 to 49 years of age, your swim test time must be 3:00 minutes or less; 3) between 50-59 years of age, your swim test time must be 3:05 minutes or less. Goggles and swim caps are permitted, but diving starts are not. All lifeguards will be required to complete the Wilson "Bud" Peck 1000-meter ocean swim.

The following dates will be the only four times the test will be held. You may attempt to pass the test on any two of these dates. You may only take the swim test a total of two (2) times. If you do not pass the swim test you will **not be hired as a Long Beach Township ocean lifeguard**.

Please be on time!

Arrangements have been made to use the St. Francis Pool for pre-season training. From April 19th – June 19th, every Tuesday and Thursday and from 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m., Monday and Wednesday from 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m., and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., three lanes of the pool have been reserved for anyone, veterans and rookies, trying out for LBTBP. Enter at the east poolside door, sign in and respect all pool rules. **There are no scheduled swim tests for lifeguard applicants after May 29th!** If we have not received your application, you will not be on the list at the St. Francis Aquatic Center for pre-test and pre-season pool training.

Orientation Meeting

Job description and job duties will be discussed as will other related subjects— work hours, salaries, LBTBP beach policies, patrol officers, etc. Patrol assignments will take place at this time. You must wear shoes & a shirt or you will be sent home. Uniforms and equipment will be distributed later the same day; the schedule will be announced at the orientation meeting. Please be on time. **Attendance is mandatory**; lifeguards will be paid for their presence.

2010 LBTBP Health and Safety Course

Schedules for all LBTBP courses are below. **You must return the enclosed course registration form to sign up for the course(s) you need.** All are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are limited to the first 25 people that register for each class. An additional way to sign up for a course is to call headquarters at (609) 361-1200 and speak with Tracey Schmidt directly if you cannot send in the course registration form that is attached with this mailing. If you are not on time for a course your space may be filled. *You cannot work until the training officer certifies you have completed all requirements (CPR/AED/AEO/PDT, Emergency Response, OLTC or LIT 2nd Level Program, swim test, necessary paperwork, Hepatitis B vaccination or completed declination form and background check and physical for those 18 yrs of age and older.).*

All CPR/AED/AEO/PDT and Emergency Response courses meet in the All-Purpose Room or court room at the James J. Mancini Administration Building (6805 Long Beach Blvd., Brant Beach). **Do not park** on 68th Street or in the building's parking lot— **park across the street in Bayview Park.** Please enter the building using the east (ocean side) entrance and proceed to the second floor. *You must wear a shirt and shoes or you will be sent home.* Participants in any American Red Cross Course must pay the \$10.00 fee for certification cards. This fee is due at the beginning of the first class session.

Instructor Courses

All LBTBP **officers** must be currently certified as an **Instructor** in American Red Cross Emergency Response, and must be currently certified in Emergency Response (or higher). Any officer who has allowed their instructor certification to lapse or anyone who is interested in becoming an officer is required to take this course. There will be one instructor course offered this season, please refer to the information below for dates and times. Completing this instructor course **will** automatically re-certify your CPR, AED, AEO, and PDT certifications and will fulfill all of your training requirements for the season. If you sign up for this course do not sign up for anything else!

Professional Rescuer CPR/AED/Administering Emergency Oxygen and Preventing Disease Transmission

If you are currently Emergency Response certified you must still need to re-certify your CPR/AED/AEO/PDT each year. If you have a current CPR/AED/AEO/PDT certification from an outside source you must submit a copy. Keep in mind any outside certification must be American Red Cross (AHA, NSC, ECSI, etc. are not accepted) *and* it must be current through the end of September 2010! If your certification card does not meet these requirements you must sign up for and complete a CPR/AED/AEO/PDT course through LBTBP before you will be allowed to begin work on the beach.

Emergency Response

Emergency Response is a comprehensive first aid course. This certification is required of all LBTBP lifeguards and is good for 3 years. **(The first day of this course will be CPR/AED/AEO/PDT, therefore you do not need to sign up for one of the CPR/AED/AEO/PDT courses listed on the reverse).** In order to accommodate those still in school at the beginning of the season, both weekend and weekday courses will be offered this season. Emergency Response courses are 4 days in length, either running from Monday through Thursday or on four consecutive Saturdays. **Please note: if your Emergency Response expires (3 year certification) this season (and you are not an Emergency Response Instructor), you will be required to complete a full Emergency Response course!**

Ocean Lifeguard Training Course (OLTC)

You must pass the swim test and Emergency Response to qualify for OLTC. However, successful completion of OLTC DOES NOT GUARANTEE EMPLOYMENT AS A LBTBP LIFEGUARD.

OLTC will be held at the 68th Street bay and ocean beaches in Brant Beach— park in the Bayview Park parking lot. The course meets at the beginning of each day under the pavilion in Bayview Park. **Be on time!!!** Wear a swimsuit and bring a wetsuit, a pair of aqua socks, warm clothes, sunscreen and water to drink. We will go over the use of radios, whistles, rescue cans, rescue paddleboards, rescue lines, surfboats, and other lifesaving equipment, techniques, and policies. You may sign out an OLTC manual up to 3 days before your course begins so you can read/study in advance (this is highly recommended).

All first-year lifeguards (who have not completed the second level of the LBTBP LIT Program) and any **lifeguards/LIT's** (based on prior evaluations) that may need additional training will be required to take this course. Be sure you register for Emergency Response as well as OLTC! As with all other courses, you must return the enclosed course registration form to sign up or by calling Beach Patrol Headquarters at (609) 361-1200.

2010 LBTBP Competition Calendar

All guards are required to complete: in order to demonstrate on-going in-ocean rescue competency

One ocean swimming event (complete one or more) Run-swim-run, **1000m swim (Required event)**, surf rescue (rescuer only), any Mayor's Cup swim.

Two other ocean events Any two events that take place in the ocean, *excluding* the event that counts as your ocean swimming event.

One other event Any event not used to satisfy either of the previous requirements. Beach flags may *not* be used as an event.

All competitors are expected to help set up for and clean up after each race. *Three events*, including *one ocean swimming event* and one *ocean event*, must be completed by July 27. Guards not meeting this requirement may be suspended or removed from the employment position designated "LBTBP Ocean Lifeguard". **The 1000m swim is required of all lifeguards!**

In events with heats and finals, event credit is given only for the heats. If you qualify for later rounds, you must participate or you will not receive credit for the event (the only exceptions are if you notify the scorekeeper at the time of qualification that you will not be able to participate or if you have a documented emergency). Ocean events are preceded by a "◇". Some events in tournaments preceded by a "‡" are ocean and/or swimming events; ask the beach patrol supervisor, chief or your captain for additional information. The LBIBPA Tournament does not count toward the competition requirement.

Each patrol has been assigned several LBTBP competitions, as noted in the rightmost column. The patrol assigned to a competition is responsible for preparing equipment the night before the event and supplying people to help run and judge the competition. Although some of the set-up and much of the clean up will be done by the competitors, the assigned patrol is ultimately responsible for all aspects of the competition.

The top three finishers in each LBTBP event are awarded medals (or, in the case of the Art Jocher Cup, trophies). Events marked with "(M, W)" have separate medals for men and women.

Important Information: Hepatitis B vaccination information

The New Jersey department of health in accord with PEOSHA blood borne pathogens standard regulations (29 CFR 1910.1030) requires Hepatitis B vaccinations (HBV) to be offered to public employees who may have contact with blood or potentially infectious materials because of their work. LBTBP will provide information on HBV vaccination addressing its safety, benefits, efficacy, methods of administration, and availability. The three-vaccine HBV series will be made available at no cost to employees who have the potential for occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials unless written documentation is shown for one of the following:

- The employee has previously received the series;
- Antibody testing reveals that the employee is immune;
- Medical reasons prevent taking the vaccination; or
- The employee chooses not to participate.

All employees are strongly encouraged to receive the HBV series. However, if an employee chooses to decline HBV, then the employee must sign a statement to this effect. Documentation of refusal of the HBV will be kept at LBTBP headquarters with the employee's other records.

First year guards only: If you choose not to participate in the HBV program, the enclosed declination statement *must* be returned with your application.

To schedule Vaccination:

Vaccination appointments are available June 30th and July 1st, 2010. Contact the LBI Health Department directly at (609) 492-1212 and ask for Anita to schedule an appointment. There you will make arrangements for your second shot, which will be administered in August; your third shot will be administered in July 2011. **Don't forget: if you began the series last summer you must make an appointment to receive your third shot!**

All vaccinations are given at the LBI Health Department, 11601 Long Beach Blvd., Haven Beach

First year guards: If you do not either sign the declination statement or receive the vaccinations, you will be unable to work as an ocean lifeguard for Long Beach Township.
